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- Philadelphia's only recovery high school for students in grades 9 – 12 who have struggled with substance use disorder and co-occurring mental health concerns
- A private school, but is **tuition-free** for Pennsylvania families
- Strong academic program is offered that integrates **recovery supports** throughout the day
- **Credit recovery** is offered so that students can work to get as close as possible to their original graduation date
- Almost 90% of our students graduate high school, and about 85% of Bridge Way graduates go to college, a trade program, or the military
- **Recovery supports are provided in partnership with CORA Services.** A clinical coordinator is on site for each school day to provide group and individual counseling. She also coordinates communication between all adults working with the student: parents/guardians, CUA workers, probation officers, IOP counselors, individual and family therapists, prescribing doctors for students accessing medically assisted recovery
- Each student develops a **recovery plan** and meets weekly with a **recovery coach**
- Case management services are provided for the student and their family as necessary
- Up to 30 students can be served, though we are keeping enrollment at 15 right now due to COVID (We currently have 8 spots available)
